Introduction to Spirit and Spirit Communication

Communication is possible only through compliance with God's law. It is a most sacred communing, afforded to humanity through God's grace, and we on the physical plane should approach it with reverence and appreciation. Spirits, the spirits of our so-called dead, once men, women and children who lived their lives on earth, have survived the change called death. They still possess their conscious individuality and identity, and they seek to commune with us by laws which men of science and those in the common ranks of life do not as yet understand.

Immorality and Transition

Natural science has not as yet, come forth with a proof of immortality. It is true that many scientists have offered the opinion that some day science will defend and offer proof of life beyond the grave, but there still remain questions which the average material mind cannot answer. This, though, must be recognized: A process in simple arithmetic is not a matter of science, as far as a kindergarten pupil is concerned. Nor has an operation in algebra any meaning for the pupil who has never gone beyond simple arithmetic. Thus it is with geometry, trigonometry, botany or any of the other exact or natural sciences.

These are but a few of the subjects, including documented case histories that you will find within these pages. Included are: Apparitions; Poltergeists; Hauntings; Ghost Lights; Nature Spirits; Fairies; Thought-Forms; Devas; Demons; Psychic Attack; Spirit Teachers; Spirit Bands; Spirit Control; Spirit Guides; Angels; Guardian Spirit; and Drop-In Communicators.
